






God wants people to communicate with Him through praying and reading the Bible daily.




DAILY BIBLE READING

MATTHEW 5:1-2; 6:5-13

Great crowds of people followed Jesus. When Jesus saw them, He went up on a mountain and sat down. His disciples came to Him, and He began to teach.

Jesus taught the people how to pray. He said: "Do not be like the people who love when others see them pray aloud in the synagogues or on the street corners. They want everyone to see them and be impressed with their words. Instead, go into your room where you are alone and shut the door. God will see you and reward you."



Jesus continued, "Don't say the same words over and over, like people who worship idols. They think they will be heard because they use many words. God knows the things you need even before you ask."

This is how Jesus taught the people to pray. (Read Matthew 6:9-13 from the translation of your choice.)

(The verses in the King James Version:)

Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.

Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.

Give us this day our daily bread.

And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.

And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

(The verses in the Christian Standard Bible translation:)

Our Father in heaven, your name be honored as holy.

Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Give us today our daily bread.

And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.

And do not bring us into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.
